





VVCC Bikes-for-Kids Program

The Verde Valley Cyclists Coalition's Bikes-for-Kids Program is focused on getting kids in grades K-12 from low income families in the Verde Valley outside and active by providing them with bicycles, helmets, and

encouraging an active lifestyle. We do this by raising funds to purchase new/used bikes, helmets, inspect/certify donated used bikes as safe and refurbishing any used bicycles that are cost effective to do so.

The VVCC works with Verde Valley school administrators, churches and other community outreach organizations to identify candidates for bikes.

We then match these candidates with volunteer mentors to work with recipients in keeping the bikes running and safe. These volunteer mentors also provide, when required, basic instruction on:

- How to ride a bike
- maintenance (tire pressure/tread, quick releases, wheel wobble, brakes, chain and lube)
- repair (flat tires, broken chains)
- road hazards and safety

Recreation is a natural byproduct of the VVCC Bikes for Kids Program. This program provides a focused and meaningful impact in the Verde Valley where kids live, play and go to school. We know that there are many Verde Valley residents who can't afford bikes for their children who won't be able to experience the joy of riding and bike ownership.

The VVCC also knows that we have to create an atmosphere where kids and families embrace biking and go on adventures around the neighborhood, local parks and trails. We accomplish this through three priorities as follows:

- Bikes Access Kids in grade K-12 from low income families earn a bike through academic achievement
- Riding Empowerment This program serves and underserved community segment
- Safety Education We work to change attitudes and beliefs by providing the opportunity through our mentoring program for recipients to encourage VERDE VALLEY CYCLISTS COALITION recipients to wear a helmet
