VVCC Community Outreach

The Verde Valley Cyclists Coalition's Community Outreach activities are diverse and open to evolution in response to Verde Valley resident needs. These activities include:

- Youth programs supporting local schools' cycling activities
- Kids helmet distributions at various community events
- Bike lanes added to SR-179 & 89A (2010); Sedona Bike Skills Park (2016); ADOT taking over SR-179 sweeping responsibility (2018)
- 40 workdays/1,600 volunteer hours to the Red Rock Ranger District, Dead Horse State Park and Sedona Bike Skills Park
- Semi-annual Adopt-A-Highway cleanups on SR-89A and quarterly Sweeping of SR-179 (2011-2017)
- Bicycle Friendly Communities designation by the League of American Bicyclists -Cottonwood – Bronze/Sedona – Silver

- Raising \$100,000+ for trail maintenance work and new trail construction in the Red Rock Ranger District
- Securing bicycles for selected veterans, the homeless, and low-income residents of the Verde Valley through partnership with Chain Reaction
- Operating the all volunteer Red Rock Mountain Bike Patrol which assists both cyclists and hikers
- Information booth at the Sedona Mountain Bike Festival raising funds & increasing awareness
- Website with current information about biking news, events, and trails
- Working with other community organizers to develop policies that support cycling in the Verde Valley
- Bike Rodeos for kids at Sedona and Cottonwoood schools
- Sedona Ride of Silence
