

- Exciting new trails in West Sedona.
- Western Gateway Trail System adds more than 21 miles of new trails.
- Plans include trails emanating from Girdner Trailhead to accommodate multiple use types and offer a variety of challenge levels and experiences.
- A major funding initiative for VVCC in 2018
- Construction will likely begin in fall, 2018, pending the availability of funds.
- Estimated construction costs exceed \$50,000, in addition to installation of comprehensive trailhead amenities.
